October 24: Lindsey (one of my interpreting students) and I started a **beginners sign language class** at church. We have seven individuals in the class! The goal is for Lindsey to teach the class after I leave. **Pray that new deaf ministry workers would be called from this class.** One of the couples in the class also has a one-year-old deaf son. **Pray for this family as they begin learning how to communicate with their son.**



December 22: One of my interpreting students and I interpreted the **church Christmas drama**. Praise the Lord for a clear presentation of the Gospel! **Pray that more souls would be saved and that the deaf ministry would grow!**

December 26 – January 24: I spent **four weeks** with a fellow missionary family in **Romania**. My main purpose for being there was to help take care of the children (a three-year-old and two-year-old twins) and the daily household responsibilities while the husband (Ben) was traveling with our director to teach at a retreat. While Ben was gone, Marie (his wife) and I also worked on several projects around the house: switching the children's bedrooms, organizing the storage closet, and setting up the baby things (their baby is due at the end of February). While I was there, they also celebrated their two-year anniversary of arriving in Romania! My time with their family has left



me both challenged and encouraged! **Pray for the family as they continue to learn Romanian and prepare for the baby!**

October 28 – November 1: I had the opportunity to attend a **missions conference** with my mission board director and his wife. It was encouraging to hear the testimonies from the other missionaries, and we were able to have several good conversations with students. While I was staying in the girls' dorm, I had the opportunity to share my testimony with the ladies at evening devotions. **Pray that these students would be challenged to give their lives to missions!**

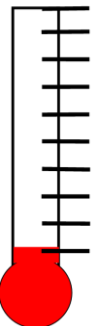
