the deaf school I visited last September. While there, I met and worked with two national women. One of them had already been at the deaf school for two years, receiving specialized training in working with the deaf. Their goal is to start a new deaf school in their home state of The new school is planned to open in March 2026, and I will be leaving in January 2026 for a six-month trip to support them at the beginning. Therefore, I need to have most of my financial support raised before the end of the year. After this trip, I will return to the United States to continue deputation.

**Deputation has officially begun!** Over the past two months, I have spoken at seven different churches, a Christian school, a homeschool co-op, and two deaf events across South Carolina, Georgia, and Missouri. God has blessed me with new supporting churches, and my current support level is approximately 17%. *Please pray for safety on the roads and* 



for wisdom in scheduling meetings and presenting the ministry. Please also pray that more churches will choose to partner with me! **February 23**: The sign language class at my sending church presented the song they had been practicing in class! It is such a blessing to see their progress! Lindsey is doing a great job leading the class while I am away!

**March 3:** I helped fellow missionary **Hannah Holmquist** pack in preparation for her move to Cambodia. Together, we organized, packed, and cataloged nine suitcases!



March 20-27: My mission director, David Bennett,



hosted a Deliberate Discipleship Retreat, which I attended. Fifteen pastors, missionaries, their wives, and other faithful servants were

challenged to better walk in the Spirit in order to edify the body of Christ and glorify God.
