The Garden Deaf School, is still on track to open in April 2026! I plan to leave in February to spend five months working with the pastor and his family as the new school gets started. After that, I will return to the United States to finish my deputation. **Please pray that my visa application will be processed smoothly.**

Once I reach my support goal, I hope to return to the deaf school that I visited in 2024 for further training with the school's founder. **Please pray for guidance on these next steps and that this region will soon ease its restrictions on foreigners.**



Updating a Supporting Church

2025 Deaflympics — Tokyo, Japan:

Approximately 3,000 athletes from over 80 countries gathered for this international event. Our **team of 14**—ranging from missionaries to computer programmers—distributed over **14,000 gospel materials** and had dozens of conversations with athletes, coaches, and spectators. Praise the Lord for **2 salvation decisions** that were made! We saw God open doors that only He could! We all returned home with increased faith and a renewed burden for lost souls; in fact, two team members gained a specific burden for the Deaf!



We also had the joy of encouraging fellow Japanese Christians. For two Sundays, we attended a Japanese church that has a huge heart for the Deaf. One week, during a special afternoon Deaf service, our group sang "Amazing Grace" in both Japanese and Japanese Sign Language. Based on the church members' reactions, we must have done well! On our final Sunday, we visited a Deaf church where several of us gave testimonies. These Deaf Japanese believers may live on the other side of the world from you and me, but we serve the same God, love the same Lord, and worship the same King!

On the Road: October and November took me through South Carolina, North Carolina, Georgia, Tennessee, and Maine. I had the opportunity to speak in **13 churches**—including **two missions conferences**—and had the privilege of speaking to the elementary students at a Christian school and teaching a ladies' Sunday school class.
